

REGISTRATION

CHESS

With an experienced and dedicated teacher, the students will be introduced to the game of chess, developing logical thinking, self-confidence and the ability to concentrate in a stimulating, structured and fun environment.

Each lesson includes instruction at the start of class, purposeful practice, and review. The chess teaching program has nine levels, from beginners to advanced players. Part of every lesson is actual chess play with the instructor supervising the games and offering tips and advice. Exercise sheets are provided each week and at the end of each course a certificate of achievement is awarded to each student

JUNKYARD SYMPHONY RHYTHM & RECYCLING

Junkyard Symphony's Rhythm and Recycling Workshops are a radical ride of rhythm. Children learn the importance of rhythm in music and life. In a drum circle fashion using reused materials for percussion instruments Junkyard Symphony teaches the basics of rhythm, such as tempo, beat, dynamics, musical notes as well as syncopated rhythms.

Add in a cheer box and a few rhythmic games and the workshop becomes a 'Stomp' for students. The importance of recycling and the Four R's, Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, and Rock is covered as students learn how to have fun while helping the earth.

LITTLE DOCTORS

Through role-play and activities, students will learn the key responsibilities of a doctor and explore the heart, lungs and digestion. Students will use real medical instruments like a stethoscope, reflex hammer, and blood pressure cuff. They will practice scrubbing, suturing, and tying knots like a real surgeon. Students will explore the human optical system and different parts of the ear. These future doctors will learn about life-saving skills, emergency preparedness, nutrition, using splints/casts, and how to read X-rays." Students will graduate with a diploma at the end of the course.

RACQUET SPORTS CLASS

Certified coach Sean Fowler has been teaching racquet sports for over 19 years. He will introduce badminton and pickleball, in a fun and interactive way.
